"Have you ever heard of a Draconic Treat?" asked Briar. "It makes a dragon's fireballs stronger and change colour! It's my favourite sweet!"

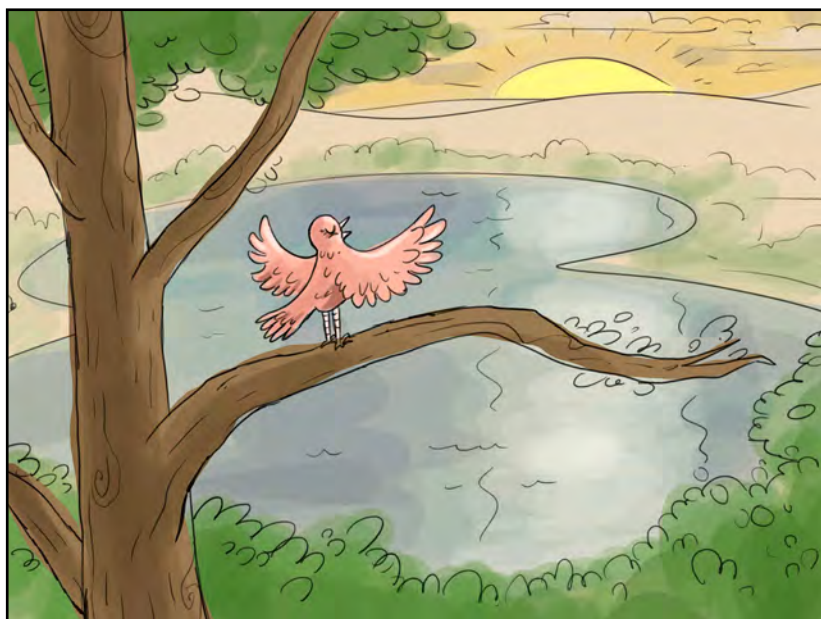
Dave replied, "I haven't heard of it, but I promise we'll make it when we open the shop. Maybe it will attract other members of your species?"

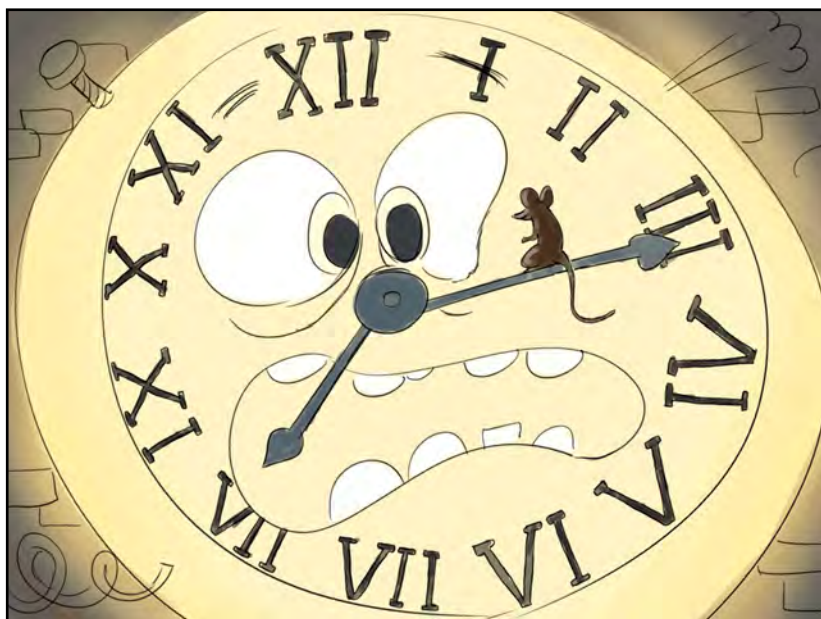
Smoke was gathering around them...

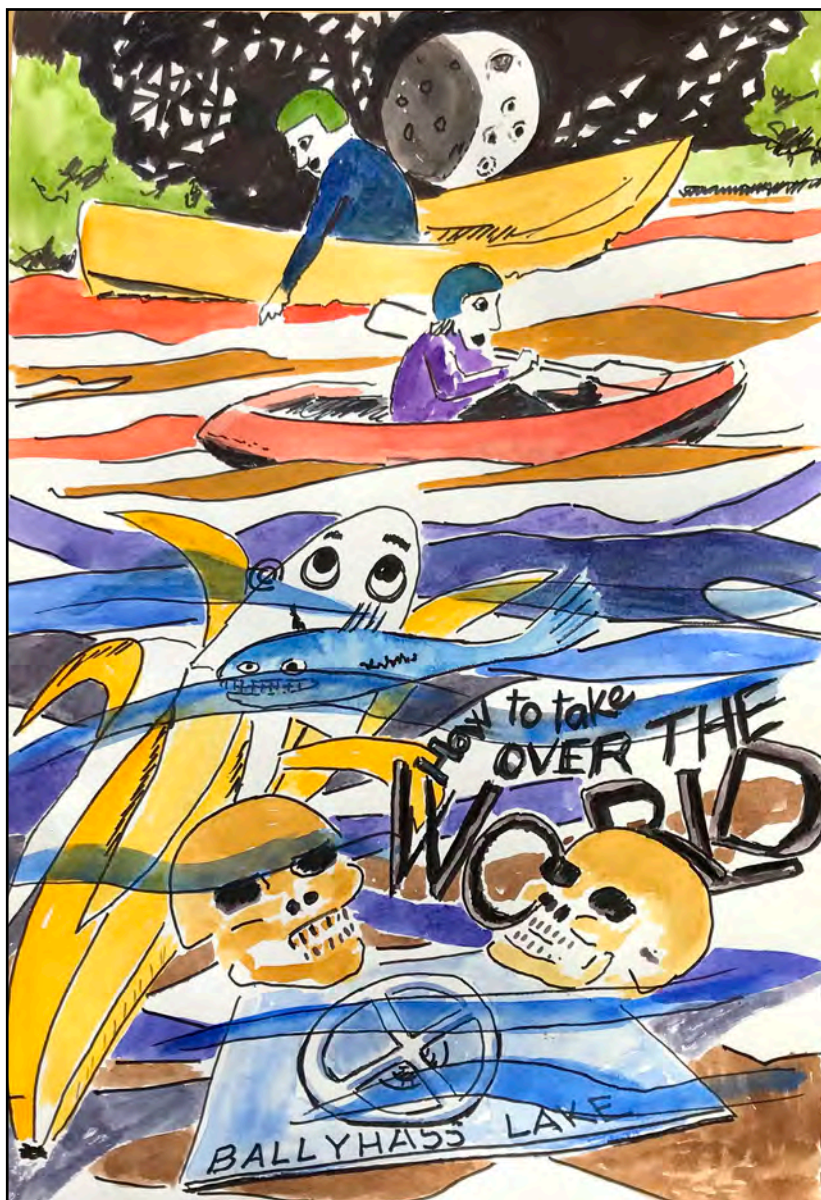
